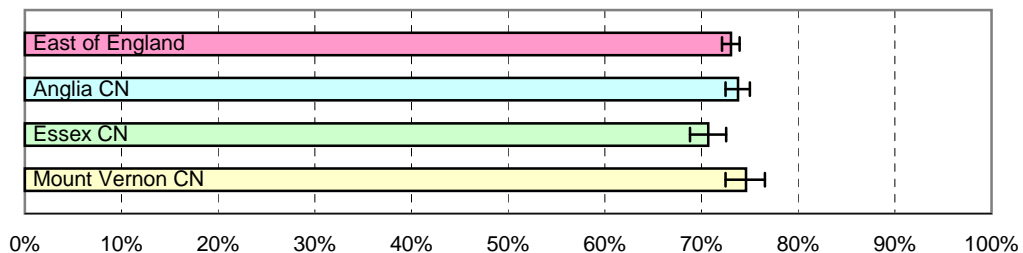


1 year relative survival rates - Haematological and haematopoietic cancers: ICD-10 C81-C85, C88, C90-C96, D45-D47

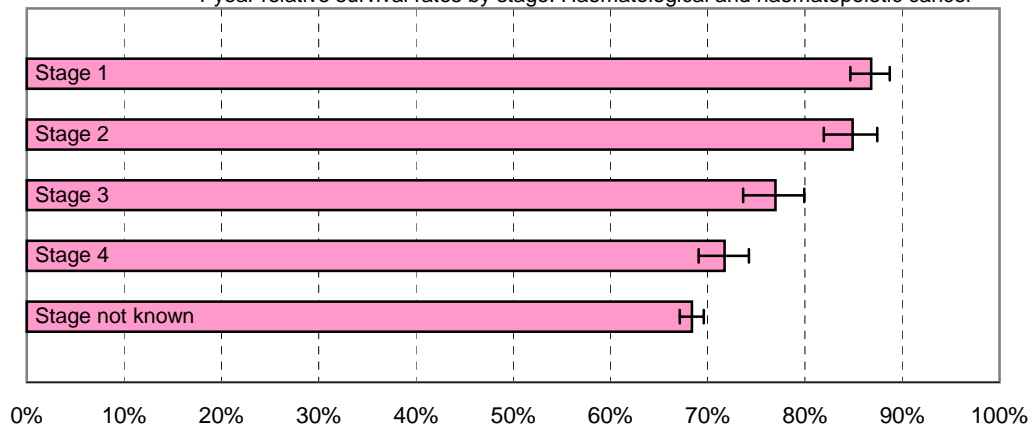
